HB 527
Status

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR STATE LIFEGUARDS. FIN
Appropriates funds for salaries and benefits for lifeguards for Kua bay, Kekaha Kai state park, on the island of Hawaii, an area under the jurisdiction of DLNR.

HB 749
Status

RELATING TO THE ENVIRONMENT. FIN
Imposes on wholesalers and dealers a beach clean-up cigarette fee per cigarette sold, used, or possessed. Establishes and allocates moneys generated to the Beach Clean-Up Special Fund for litter removal from beach land.

HB 971
Status

RELATING TO ALOHA TOWER DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION. FIN
To change the membership of the Board of Directors of the Aloha Tower Development Corporation.

HB 775, HD1
(HSCR369)
Status

RELATING TO EDUCATION. EDB, HED, FIN
Appropriates funds to the department of business, economic development, and tourism for marketing Hawaii's higher education institutions to international students.

HB 1329, HD1
(HSCR293)
Status

RELATING TO THE ISSUANCE OF SPECIAL PURPOSE REVENUE BONDS FOR ASSISTING AN INDUSTRIAL ENTERPRISE. EDB, FIN
Authorizes the issuance of SPRBs to four separate projects of Paradise Ohana, Automotive Training & Education, LLC.

HB 1345, HD1
(HSCR248)
Status

RELATING TO AGRICULTURE. AGR, FIN
Appropriates funds for the operation, repair, maintenance, and improvement of the East Kauai Water Users' Cooperative irrigation systems.



HB 1453, HD1
(HSCR366)
Status

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE MOLOA'A WELL
PROJECT ON THE ISLAND OF KAUAI.

EEP/WAL, FIN

Appropriates funds for land acquisition, plans, design, and construction of a new well, alternative energy development to power the well, and a post-harvest facility at Moloa'a on the island of Kauai.

PAPER: 2 copies (including an original) to Room 306 in the State Capitol;


FAX: For testimony less than 5 pages in length, transmit to 1-800-535-3859 (for Neighbor Islander without a computer to submit testimony through e-mail or the Web); or

Testimony submitted will be placed on the legislative website. This public posting of testimony on the website should be considered when including personal information in your testimony.
