Call to Order

Chair Greg King called the meeting to order at 1:00 PM.

Minutes

Mr. Russ Saito made a motion, seconded by Mr. Leslie Chinen, to approve the minutes of the July 13, 2006 meeting.

The motion was carried unanimously and the minutes were approved as distributed.

Agenda Item III.

Deputy Attorney General Pat Ohara submitted a proposed policy for the Board to consider that had been adapted from the policies of other boards and commissions. The policy allows the Board to exercise its discretion to limit the submission of information by weighing factors such as the amount of people, the available time, the complexity of the issues, etc.

Mr. Richard Totten made a motion, seconded by Mr. Saito, to adopt the policy whereby the Board shall allow all interested persons an opportunity to submit or present data, views, arguments, and testimony on any agenda item in an open meeting, but that the Board may impose limitations on the submission of data, views, arguments, or testimony in the interest of preserving fairness within the constraints of an open meeting.

The motion was unanimously carried.

Agenda Item IV.

Ms. Ruth Yamaguchi provided brief comments on several sections proposed for amendments.

Mr. Gordon Ing made a motion, seconded by Mr. Totten, to adopt the amendments and compilation of the proposed rules for interim rules.

Mr. Ing inquired if the concerns raised at the last meeting were addressed and Ms. Yamaguchi replied that they were. Following the discussion the motion was unanimously approved.

Agenda Item V.

Mr. Saito made a motion, seconded by Mr. Chinen, to withdraw this agenda item relating to proposed interim rules for small business assistance to allow the various interested parties to meet and discuss such draft rules and if possible, to submit to the Board, a mutually agreed upon proposed set of rules at the next meeting.

After a brief discussion, whereby SPO had no objections, the motion was unanimously carried.

Agenda Items VI, VII, and VIII

Ms. Ohara provided some background information on the inclusion of agenda items VI and VII as action items in today's agenda, stating that OIP had recommended the Board revisit the two petitions for rule adoption and rule amendment. She also recommended that since agenda item VIII, the third petition, is on the same topic as items VI and VII, the exemption of public, education, and government ("PEG") access services from the State procurement code, the petitions be grouped together for discussion purposes, and the testimony for all three petitions be heard at the same time.

Mr. Saito made a motion, seconded by Mr. Totten, to group the three petitions together for discussion purposes.

The motion was unanimously carried.

Chair King informed the attendees that the Board would not be imposing a time limit, but due to the large number of testifiers, requested everyone to keep their comments brief.

Mr. Aaron Fujioka provided the Board comments and recommendations on the three petitions. At the request of the Board, Mr. Clyde Sonobe of DCCA responded to various questions raised by the Board regarding PEG access services. Individuals on Attachment B presented testimony

At 2:50 pm Chair King called a recess and reconvened the meeting at 3:05 pm and continued to receive testimonies from individuals on Attachment B.

The Board terminated testimonies for the day and upon further discussion agreed that SPO would survey all of the Board members for a date, time and place to reconvene the meeting.

Chair King recessed the meeting at 4:40 pm. The meeting was reconvened on October 5, 2006 at 9:05 am at the same location. Board members Mr. Chinen and Ms. Daryle Ann Ho were excused from this portion of the meeting.

Mr. Saito made a motion, seconded by Mr. Totten, to limit the oral testimony to address why it is not advantageous or practicable to compete the PEG access services and to limit the time to 5-7 minutes. After a brief discussion about the need to address the relative merits of competing the PEG access services, the motion was unanimously carried, and the board continued receiving oral testimony on agenda items VI, VII and VIII from individuals on Attachment B.

Chair King called a recess at 10:38 am and reconvened the meeting at 10:49 am and continued receiving oral testimony.

Mr. Silva requested permission to present additional oral testimony on behalf of Olelo. Mr. Silva had already testified to the Board on September 22. Mr. Saito made a motion, seconded by Mr. Totten, to limit persons to testifying once on the same subject. During discussion, Ms. Ohara said it was acceptable to have the petitioner, or their attorney, summarize their petition, and here, Mr. Silva, speaking as the Chief Financial Officer of Olelo, represented the petitioner. The motion was withdrawn and Mr. Silva presented his testimony.

Chair King called a recess at 12:24 pm and reconvened the meeting at 1:17 pm and continued receiving oral testimony.

Upon completion of all testifiers, the Board called upon Mr. Clyde Sonobe, Ms. Carol Bain and Mr. Silva to answer questions from the board. Chair King thanked all those who came to testify.

Mr. Saito made a motion, seconded by Mr. Totten that the Board go into executive session to consult with the Board's attorney. The motion was unanimously carried, and the executive session started at 2:25 pm.

Chair King called the meeting back to order at 4:37 pm.

Agenda Item VI.

Mr. Totten moved to deny the petition requesting the adoption of a rule to exclude from the State Procurement Code, public education government access provider contracts which direct the cable franchisees to cause payments from the cable franchise fees to the several public education government access providers. Mr. Ing seconded the motion. Discussion followed, and the motion was unanimously carried.

Agenda Item VII.

Mr. Totten moved to deny the petition for the modification of HAR § 3-120-4(b), Exhibit A, the list of procurements exempt from the State Procurement Code, to include the services of non-governmental non-profit corporations providing public, educational, and governmental cable access. Mr. Ing seconded the motion. Discussion followed, and the motion was unanimously carried.

Agenda Item VIII.

Stating that the Board has the authority to entertain this petition for declaratory relief, Mr. Saito requested an opinion from Ms. Ohara on whether the board may separate the two issues stated in the petition and address them separately. Ms. Ohara replied in the affirmative.

Mr. Saito made a motion, seconded by Mr. Totten, to approve the petition's request to consider PEG access services as comparable to utility services ("utility-like") and therefore exempt from the State Procurement Code. Discussion followed. Mr. Saito and Mr. Totten voted in favor of the motion, and Mr. King and Mr. Ing voted against. The motion failed.

Mr. Saito made a motion, seconded by Mr. Ing, to deny the second issue raised in the petition for declaratory ruling, that it is neither practicable nor advantageous to compete PEG access services under the State Procurement Code. Discussion followed. Mr. King stated the presumption of the State Procurement Code, and the Board, is that everything should be bid, unless it is shown that it is neither practical or advantageous to do so, and that no one testifying had made a convincing presentation that such was the case with contracts with PEG access organizations. The motion was unanimously carried.

However, to address the concerns of the audience and the Board, the Board questioned Mr. Sonobe and Mr. Fujioka about the RFP process. Mr. Saito made a motion, seconded by Mr. Totten, requesting the SPO and DCCA to provide the Board a progress report on the status of the RFP in six weeks. Discussion followed and Mr. Fujioka stated that during the RFP process, if the SPO determined that it was not advantageous or practicable to proceed with an RFP, the SPO would reconsider an exemption. The motion was unanimously carried.

Mr. Ing made a motion, seconded by Mr. Totten, that after the Request For Information (RFI) and public informational hearings are conducted, the SPO/DCCA will provide the Board an update. The motion was unanimously carried.

Agenda Item IX.

Mr. Fujioka requested that the board hold this item, HHSC's request for additional exemptions from the State Procurement Code, in abeyance until the next meeting, October 27, 2006, because HHSC and SPO are in discussions regarding the concerns of HHSC and how those concerns may be resolved. The request was approved by the Board.


Agenda Item X.

Mr. Saito made a motion, seconded by Mr. Ing, to place this item, the election of officers, on the next meeting's agenda. The motion was unanimously carried.

Motion to adjourn was made by Mr. Ing and seconded by Mr. Saito. There being no further announcements, the meeting was adjourned at 5:17 pm.
